1. 14th International Summit on the Teaching Profession (ISTP).

On Monday, 22 April 2024, SLPS will be hosting international delegates participating in the 14th International Summit on the Teaching Profession (ISTP). This summit, organized by Singapore in collaboration with the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) and Education International (EI), brings together educators from around the world to discuss teaching practices and education policies.

This prestigious event, held annually by invitation only, gathers representatives from 34 countries, including Austria, Canada, China, Finland, Japan, Norway, Republic of Korea, Switzerland, and the United States, to share best practices and discuss strategies aimed at enhancing the teaching profession and improving student achievement.

SLPS is among the select two primary schools designated by the MOE, alongside seven other schools comprising secondary, junior colleges, and specialized independent schools, to demonstrate the future of learning in schools. During their 1.5-hour visit, delegates will experience firsthand how SLPS teachers promote engaged learning among students. They will also learn about the school's approach to fostering future-ready competencies through its unique school program, innovative teaching methods, and immersive learning environments.
